Dear Wedding Guests,

We're so excited for you to be joining us here at the Woods at Oakley. Here's some useful information to make your visit as magical as possible!

### **GETTING HERE**

Follow your directions for 'The Woods at Oakley'. The postcode SP3 5EU will lead you to the correct road, which is called 'Marshwood', but won't be specific enough. The turning to take has a sign that says, 'The Woods at Oakley' and written underneath 'Oakley Farm'. Don't turn into 'Oakley House' as that is a private property, or 'Oakley Business Park'.

When you arrive, drive straight ahead through the entrance signposted 'The Woods at Oakley'. Follow the track through the paddock to the parking area - Donkey Hill. From there you can walk into the woods. **Please do not drive your cars through the pedestrian entrance.** If you need to drop anything off at the reception, take the track on the left and follow the signs for "suppliers". This is for drop off only not parking.

The ceremony will take place in 'The Hazel Bower, which will be on your right as you walk down the wood's main track and is a 2-minute walk from Donkey Hill Parking. The wedding reception will take place in 'The Bluebell Glade', which is on your left as you walk down the wood's main track. This is also where the toilets are located.

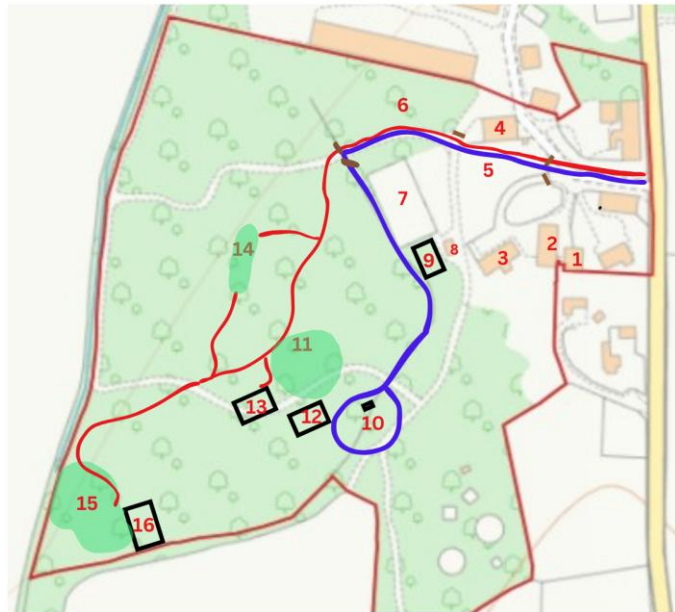
'The Oak Grove', which is located right at the end of the main woodland track, is where some guests may be glamping, so please respect this area.

### WEATHER

It's very important to remember that this is a woodland wedding venue and that we can't predict the weather! Please come prepared for all weather types as the ceremony will take place outside and you may only have the trees for cover. If it rains, we suggest wellies/waterproof shoes, umbrellas and raincoats. We can provide some umbrellas if needed. If it's very hot, we suggest cool clothes, suncream, sunglasses and sunhats. Please wear appropriate footwear for our woodland tracks and make sure you have a warmer layer for the evening.

### ACCESSIBILITY

The woodland gravel tracks are suitable for wheelchairs and buggies, but they are a little bumpy! There is an accessible, disabled toilet in the Bluebell Glade that has baby changing facilities.

### SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted by the fire pit in the Bluebell Glade and cigarette ends must be discarded into the designated sand bucket. Please do not smoke anywhere else in the woods. As this is a woodland venue, cigarettes and discarded ends present a serious fire risk, particularly during hot weather and with the increasing effects of climate change. Anyone smoking elsewhere will be asked to leave. Thank you for helping us to keep the woods safe.
